PRRMA RESIDENTS:

It has been brought to our attention that our previous notification did not reach everyone involved and for that we sincerely apologize for the inconvenience caused by this error.

Please be advised that during the next several weeks we will be performing asphalt and concrete repairs in your neighborhood. All areas being worked on have been clearly marked with fluorescent orange or fluorescent pink paint. If the concrete curbs or sidewalks in front of your driveway have been marked please do not drive across these areas until a minimum 5 day cure time has passed. If we are working in front of your driveway you will be notified in person by our foreman in the morning in order to allow you to move your vehicles out and avoid being blocked in. The current schedule has been revised to perform concrete work the week of June 21st starting on Monday weather permitting and continuing through the week until complete. Milling and paving the week of June 28th will also start on Monday weather permitting and continuing through the week until complete. We will also be seal coating portions of the roads throughout all (3) subs but you will receive a separate notification before that work begins. Please check your website for any updates that may be posted while this work is being performed. Again, if the areas in front of your home are marked in fluorescent pink or orange paint we will be working in those areas and request that you refrain from parking on these areas until the work is complete. Also if we are replacing any concrete in front of your home please turn your irrigation system off until (3) days after the concrete is poured to avoid damage to the new concrete. Please know that we will take great care to minimize any inconvenience to you and your neighbors but some inconvenience is unavoidable. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated.
